Please remember:

To participate in the RTG chipping program you must have paid RTG 2022 dues.

Residents should pile brush and tree limbs with cut ends facing out along the road/street in piles no higher than 5 feet. No large tree roots or stumps.

No grass, leaves, pine straw, poison oak, genista, cactus, ice plant, construction debris, or palm fronds.

If residents want chips left where their piles were located, talk with the chipping crew. Full loads can be dumped upon request, no partial loads.

Residents must complete this chipping request form at **least 10 days prior to the scheduled chipping dates** and return it to your Division Captain, the free library (Completed Chipping Forms), or send to Dave Wisherd; dwisherd@yahoo.com

(The Volunteer Hourly Worksheet totals must be reported to Firewise® each year.)
